

## CHENG Nam Sang

Cheng Nam Sang is an Assistant Professor at the NUS Business School. He has read Accounting and Finance at the University of Warwick and the London School of Economics & Political Science (University of London), and has received his PhD from the University of Bradford while teaching there. Nam Sang is also a chartered accountant and has worked for Price Waterhouse (a legacy firm of PricewaterhouseCoopers) in their UK and Singapore Offices.

Currently, Nam Sang is an independent director of a Singapore listed company, chairing the Audit and Remuneration Committees.
